Parts of Speech - Pronouns

The personal pronouns myself, yourself, yourselves, himself, herself, itself, ourselves, and
themselves are compound personal pronouns combining the personal pronoun with self or selves.
They are used as <i>reflexive pronouns</i> .
Example:
Carl hurt <i>himself</i> .
