

## Lesson 26

### Parts of Speech - Pronouns

**Relative pronouns** join *dependent clauses* to *independent clauses*. They are *who*, *whoever*, *whose*, *whom*, *whomever*, *which*, and *that*. Clauses will be taught in detail later.

Example:

He found his money **that** he had lost.

(**That** joins the two clauses together into one sentence.)

**Instructions:** Find the **relative pronouns** in the sentences, and see how many other pronouns you can find as a bonus.

1. I want the house, which is brick.
2. Jack ordered the meal that we picked up.
3. Freddie is the girl who won the contest.
4. Jon is a man on whom I can rely.
