## Mechanics - Capitalization

Capitalize titles preceding personal names, abbreviations of those titles used with proper names, initials, or titles when used alone in place of the name or person.

Examples:

**Mr.**, **Miss**, **Rev.**, **Dr.**, **W. C. Johanson**, **Captain**
