Mechanics - Punctuation - Commas

Use a comma to set off a short *clause* at the end of the sentence to change a statement into a question or an *exclamatory sentence*.

Example:

You are going to town, *aren't you?*

Instructions: Place commas where they are needed.

1. That should make them take notice shouldn't it!
2. This is a beautiful location isn't it?
3. Becky is a living miracle isn't she!
4. Joe was here this morning wasn't he?
5. The new player really tries doesn't he!
