Parts of Speech - Adjectives

Use *this* or *that* with **kind** or **sort** because both are singular; use *these* or *those* with **kinds** or **sorts** because both are plural.

Examples:

this or *that* **kind** of stocks

these or *those* **kinds** of stocks

this or *that* **sort** of people

these or *those* **sorts** of people
