

Lesson 85**Parts of Speech - Interjections**

An **interjection** is a word or word group that shows feeling. A **mild interjection** is followed by a **comma**; a **strong interjection** is followed by an **exclamation mark**. Interjections are rather easy to understand so we will not spend much time on them.

Examples:

Well, we will soon be home.

Oh! I didn't know he had died.

Instructions: Find the **interjection** in these sentences.

1. Dear me! That is terrible.

2. Nonsense, you can do it.

3. Wow! You look gorgeous!

4. Sh! The baby is asleep.

5. Oh, what a beautiful baby you have.
